COUNSELLING GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO VARIOUS UG/Integrated BSc-Msc/PG and DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

1. The candidates shortlisted for counselling at Central University of Kashmir are required to bring the following documents (original as well as photocopy) for verification on the date of counselling:
 - a. CUCET 2019 admit card and score card
 - b. All the marks sheets of qualifying degree examination and valid category certificate issued by the Competent Authority as per the prescribed norms of Government of India
2. OBC category candidates shall not belong to Creamy Layer, and are required to submit the certificate in GOI prescribed format. It shall be noted that RBA is not OBC category and SC means Schedule Caste, not Social Caste.
3. Mere appearing in counselling does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to the Programme, unless he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria.
4. The candidates shortlisted for M.Tech counselling under GATE category shall produce valid GATE score card at the time of counselling, failing which they shall be treated as non-GATE.
5. All shortlisted candidates called for counselling should remain present personally or attend the counselling through their authorized agent.
6. Candidates who fail to attend the counselling and/or to provide relevant documents at the time of counselling will not be allowed to seek admission.
7. All admissions shall be provisional and subject to satisfying the minimum eligibility criteria, verification of certificates/marks sheets, and other category certificates.
8. Candidates applying for more than one programme are requested to bring multiple sets of counselling forms along with the photocopies of requisite documents.
9. The selection list will be prepared purely on the basis of merit and other criteria prescribed by the University.
10. If a candidate belonging to ST/SC/OBC/PWD/EWS finds his/her place on the basis of his/her own merit in the General Category selection list, such candidate shall be adjusted against the General Category seat, if he/she has not taken any benefit on account of reservation. The seat vacated by him/ her in the reserved category shall be filled up by a candidate from the same reservation category only in order of merit.
11. Errors and omissions in the counselling lists shall be excepted, and the lists shall be liable to be revised/updated in the event of genuine error. Requests beyond 05/07/19 shall not be entertained under any circumstances. The students in their own interest are requested to note down and report the matter to the Academic Section through email at cucetenquiry@cukashmir.ac.in by or before 05/07/19.
12. Only those candidates shall be considered for counselling who have completed their qualifying degrees by or before the date of counselling. In addition to the above, candidates belonging to Ganderbal district who intend to apply for the supernumerary seat reserved for residents of Ganderbal area are advised to bring along Permanent Resident certificate in order to be considered for the seat.
