Expression of Interest (EOI) for Selection of Architect (No. EOI 01 of 2012 Dated 17.12.2012)

S.No.	Query	Explanation
1	Please clarify if overseas partner having 40 year's experience and Indian partner having continuous operative experience of 3 years will be consider for prequalification?	Section 2 Clause 04 of the EOI mentions that ' <i>The Architect should have a registered office in India with a continuous operative experience of 05 years as on the last date of submission of this EOI</i> '. It is clear from this condition that the applicant should have 05 years of operative experience in India.
2	Please clarify if a project like Legislative Assembly/Secretariat Campus in India which cost more the 500 Crores INR and area 8 lakh sqft will be considered for pre – qualification? (Even if plot area is less than 100 acres)	Section 2 Clause 03 of the EOI mentions that " <i>the Architect should have prepared & got approved Architectural Design of Buildings & its services for an institution of Higher Education/Research in India with an estimated cost of Rs 100 crores and above</i> ". Buildings other than those belonging to institution of Higher Education/Research in India shall not be considered.
3	Please clarify if designing of institutional campus project in India under implementation (not fully completed) but plot area of 250 acres will be considered for pre – qualification?	Section 2 Clause 02 of the EOI mentions that " <i>the Architect should have prepared & got approved Master Plan & Allied Services for an institution of Higher Education/Research in India with a land measuring 100 acres and above at a single location</i> ". Under-implementation Master Plan shall be considered subject to the production of the certificate regarding its acceptance/approval by the client on the prescribed format.
4	Please clarify if Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will be considered as adequate proof for joint participation.	MoU will be considered as a valid proof after getting it formalised on a Rs. 100/- Stamp Paper and notarized by a registered Notary Public.
5	We have just started a new firm. We fill all the four criteria except the 4th point which says office should be registered with experience of 5 years. I have an experience of over 10 years in the field of architecture (Townships, colleges, schools, housings, IT etc...). Are we eligible to apply?	Already clarified at S.no. 01 above.
