Expression of Interest (EOI) for Selection of Architect (No. EOI 01 of 2012 Dated 17.12.2012)

S.No.	Query	Explanation
1	Please clarify if consortium is allowed. If yes, can overseas companies participate with Indian partners?	Yes. Overseas entities may associate with Indian partner/s to form a consortium to complement their respective areas of expertise, or for other reasons. Such a consortium should however be formed through valid legal documents before the submission of EOI and the copy of the legal document should be furnished with the EOI. Further, the consortium should fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down in the EOI dated 17.12.2012. Under such circumstance, one of the Indian partner must become the lead member of the consortium and the University shall only deal with the lead member for all the purposes. Members of the consortium shall not be eligible to apply separately as sole architects or as partners of other consortia.
2	How many members can form consortium?	For the purpose of this EOI, maximum of three members are allowed to form a consortium.
3	Please clarify if projects completed overseas are considered for pre – qualification.	Only those projects which have been completed in India shall be considered for the purpose of this EOI
4	As EOI submission requires elaborate documentation, we request you to extend the date of final submission by 10 days i.e. up to 17 Jjan 2013.	As of now, there is no scope for extending the last date for submission of EOI. To avoid any inconvenience to the applicants on this part, the University has kept the provision of electronic submission (fax/email) of EOI.
