Admission Guidelines

MBA 2010 – 11

Based upon the performance of the candidates in the entrance test, group discussion & personal interview for the admission to MBA programme 2010-11, the list of provisionally selected candidates has been released and is available on the University website www.cukashmir.ac.in. The selected candidates should note that:-

1. The selection list is provisional and is subject to change on the verification of the documents and the examination data.
2. Admission of the provisionally selected candidates to the above programme will be held at Central University of Kashmir. 101, Baghi – Hyder, Hyderpora, Srinagar – 190005 (J&K) and the last date for completing the admission related formalities is 31st July, 2010.
3. Candidates are required to report for admission during the above period along with a set of attested photostat copies and the original certificates mentioned below:
 - i) Marks sheets of the qualifying examination.
 - ii) Date of birth certificate
 - iii) SC/ST/OBC/PH certificate, if applicable.
 - iv) Three copies of recent coloured photographs
 - v) Admit card/Hall Ticket of the CUCET 2010
4. Candidates who fail to complete admission formalities by the last date will forfeit their right to admission. The seats falling vacant on this count will be offered to the next available eligible candidate in the waiting list. The selection lists of such candidates as also the last date fixed for completing admission formalities will be available on the University website on August 2, 2010.
5. The admission fees of Rs. 9000/ is to be paid at the time of admission by cash or D.D drawn in favour of “Central University of Kashmir” payable at Srinagar (J&K) on any nationalized bank, failing which their offer of admission will be withdrawn.
6. Admission, if granted, is provisional. If any of the information given by the candidate is found to be incorrect, false, incomplete or concealed, the admission will be liable to be cancelled and action may be initiated against the candidate.
7. As per the Supreme Court orders, ragging in all kinds is banned within and outside the premises of the University. Any student found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately as per rules of the University/UGC guidelines.
