

Course Title: Social Justice and Civil Liberties

Course Objective: Social Justice has always remained an essentially contested concept. The discourse has often surrounded arguments favouring social goals on one side and individual liberties on the other. Several approaches have been articulated to elaborate the concept. The paper intends to introduce some of these approaches philosophically and sociologically in a comprehensible way.

Students will use the philosophical, theological, political and sociological understanding of justice to make sense of the social world.
