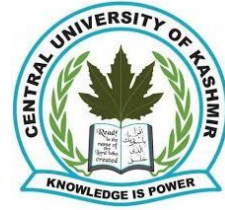

The Topic of the Debate:

“Family Socialisation is Responsible for Juvenile Delinquency”

Instructions

1. It is expected that every debater will conduct himself/herself in a dignified manner and will not use words that will annoy, humiliate or intimidate the opponent.
2. The debater has to be precise, to the point, lucid and clear in his/her presentation. He/she should take care to select appropriate words free from gestures, innuendos and sarcastic comments.
3. The purpose of the speech is not only to test the knowledge on a given topic but also to test the ability to present and communicate in the presence of an audience.

4. The College shall depute four participants (two teams of two students each). Each team shall comprise two members. One member will speak 'FOR' the motion & other 'AGAINST' the motion and will be given only 5 minutes each.
5. The contestant is not allowed to read out from any written source. There will be the first bell after 4 minutes and the final bell at the end of the 5th minute.
6. Participants are not allowed to refer to any material/books after the commencement of the competition.
7. Mobiles phones or other electronic gadgets are **strictly prohibited** into the competition area.
8. Light refreshments will be provided to all the participants.
9. Results will be announced immediately after the competition.
10. The decision of the Judges shall be final regarding the results.
