

Course Title: Introduction to Law
Course Code: IL-C-107

Course Objective: This paper aims to reorient the students about the discipline of law and make them acquainted with the basic concepts about the law, legal institutions, and legal phraseology. The meanings of some popular terms in Greek and Latin that have become part of English legal vocabulary are also explained to the students so that they do not face any difficulty in their profession or while appearing in any competitive examinations.

Course Outcome: The students will be able to differentiate between law and subordinate legislations. They will appreciate the definition of 'person', which means more than the natural person and is focal of any legal system. They will understand the reasons for different interpretations of law because of the imperfect meaning of English words and will be able to draft essential documents to seek various reliefs in the court of law.
