

Course Title: Law of Torts and Motor Vehicle Act
Course Code: IL-C-205

Course Objective: The primary goal of this course is to familiarise the students with the basics of the law of tort and make them appreciate emerging areas of this branch such as Constitutional tort, Cyber tort, Economic tort and Family tort. Students will also be able to discuss any defences available to all parties and the appropriate remedies. In addition, the course aims for students to learn the essential principles fundamental to the operation of the tort system. Furthermore, to become familiar with most of the critical and commonly litigated torts. The course also discusses intentional, strict liability, vicarious liability and negligent torts. Furthermore, students are expected to:

1. approach a factual scenario, and analyse what torts exist therein.
2. learn the essential principles fundamental to the operation of the tort system.
3. develop skills in legal analysis and argument.
4. understanding the significant torts, related principles, and criticisms will enable the student to understand the tort system.
5. learn about other torts on their own as they encounter them in their readings and research.

Course Outcome: Students graduating with Law of Torts including Motor Vehicle Act will be able to do the following:

1. Study the principles of Tortious liability, the defences available in action for torts, the capacity of parties to sue and be sued and matters connected in addition to that.
2. Discuss any defences available to all parties and the appropriate remedies.
3. Study and evaluate the specific torts against the individual and property.
4. Analyse some intentional torts concerning the rapid industrialisation, the inadequacy of the law to protect the individual is exposed.
