

Course Title: Law of Contract - I
Course Code: IL-C-301

Course Objective: This paper aims to make students understand the conditions required for a valid contract and agreements that are expressly declared void or become void. The students will also know certain relations resembling contract and their implications and damages in case of breach of contract.

Course Outcome: The students would be able to demonstrate sufficient understanding of what is an offer and acceptance and whether an offer or acceptance has been revoked or not in a given case. Whether a contract is valid or not, and whether a party is discharged from performing its promise in a case in hand. Whether in a given case, a person can be compelled to conform to specific obligations or not in the absence of a contract and whether a party has committed a breach of contract to pay damages to the opposite party.
