

Course Title: Civil Procedure Code - I and The Specific Relief Act
Course Code: IL-C-704

Course Objective: This course intends to impart the practical aspects of the Code of Civil Procedure to the learners by equipping them with a better understanding of:

- Jurisdiction of Civil Courts.
- Principles of Res Judicata and Res Sub Judice.
- Parties to the Suit, Appearance and consequences of their Non Appearance.
- Pleadings, including filling of Complaint and Written Statement.
- Execution of Decrees, with different modes of execution.

In addition, this course aims at providing the learners with practical aspects of the Specific Relief Act by equipping them with a better understanding of:

- Grant of Specific relief
- Recovery of Specific property (Movable or immovable)
- Specific performance of contracts
- Temporary and permanent injunctions

Course Outcome: By the end of the course, the learners will be able to understand and explain:

- The purpose and function of civil procedure law and the structure of the civil court organization.
- How can an action be filed, how can the defence of action be filed, what are the results of filing an action?
- List the fundamental stages of civil cases.
- Express the legal result of not filing a defence statement.
- Explain the stages of filling pleadings, oral hearing and judgment and execution of a decree.

In addition, the learners will be able to understand and explain:

- The purpose and meaning of Specific Relief Law.
- How can a person recover the property of which he has been illegally disposed of?
- Cases in which specific performance of the contract can be enforced and vice versa.
- Understanding the principles of injunction and the difference between temporary and permanent injunction.
