

Course Title: Civil Procedure Code - II and The Limitation Act
Course Code: IL-C-802

Course Objective: This course intends to impart the practical aspects of the Code of Civil Procedure to the learners by equipping them with a better understanding of:

- Modes of Execution of Decree including Arrest and detention, attachment and sale
- Suits filed by or against the Government
- Public Nuisance
- Appeal, Review and Revision
- Law of Injunction Under CPC
- Suits by or against Minors and indigent persons
- Appointment of receiver

Course Outcome: By the end of the course, the learners will be able to understand and explain:

- How a decree can be executed by taking the assistance of the Court through various modes.
- Procedure to be followed when a suit is filed by or against the Government, including sending of Notice before filing a suit.
- Understanding the various modes by which a decree passed by an inferior court can be challenged before a superior court.
- How an interim relief can be sought from the Court till the disposal of the main claim.
- Procedure to be followed when a suit is filed by or against the minor or indigent.
- Understanding the objective and role of the receiver being appointed by the Court.
