

Course Title: Cyber Law

Course Objective: Cyber law is an emerging subject that pervades most of the branches of law. This paper aims to make students understand the symbiotic relationship of law and Internet technology and its impact on the existing legal regime that was framed, keeping in view the physical world and political boundaries that the Internet has washed away. New concepts like the authentication of electronic records, digital signatures, e-commerce, e-governance and cyber crimes will be significant areas of discussion of this subject.

Course Outcome: The students will generate a digital signature and differentiate it from an electronic one. They will make out the requirement of authentication of electronic records and its impact on cyber forensic. The Cyber Law (The IT Act) is primarily a gap filler, so the students will be able to figure out additional requirements of electronic commerce and how the Indian Contract Act and IPC can still be made applicable to e-commerce or Cyber crimes respectively.
