

GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL INTERVIEW FOR ADMISSION TO MTTM PROGRAMME

1. All the shortlisted candidates must appear in both the Group Discussion (GD) and Personal Interview (PI).
2. The candidates from outside the Union Territory of J&K who wish to appear ONLINE must send their consent along with the scanned copy of the CUCET score and ID proof through email by or before **30th October 2020** at the following email address: dtscukadmissions@gmail.com.
3. The candidates appearing online shall also send scanned copies of all the required certificates (CUCET Score Card; Graduation Marks Card, Reserved Category, if applicable)
4. Only those candidates whose eligibility degree (Graduation) is complete as on the date of GD/PI are eligible to appear.
5. For online participation in GD & PI, the candidates shall remain available ONLINE from **2:00 PM** onwards on **5th November 2020**. For online GD/PI, a link will be shared with the candidates on the day of their GD-PI, and they will be provided a login Username and Password.
6. Grade/Marks for the Group Discussion shall be based on each member of the group's performance.
7. For Group discussion, the following points should be kept in mind:
 - *Allow everyone a chance to speak*
 - *The discussion shall preferably be in English.*
 - *Listen respectfully and actively.*
 - *Criticize ideas, not individuals.*
 - *Commit to learning, not debating.*
 - *Avoid blames, speculations, inflammatory languages.*
 - *Avoid assumptions about others, especially based on the perceived social group.*
8. Each group shall be given two minutes to think about the particular topic, and then the group shall be left for 15 minutes to discuss and conclude the subject given.
9. For GD, groups will be created at the venue for all the Kashmir based candidates.
10. Each candidate shall face the panel interview, and marks will be assigned accordingly.

Note: Mere appearance in GD and PI does not earn the candidate any claim for admission.
