M.A. English	Bachelors Degree with at least 50% of marks* having English Literature as one of the subjects.
M.A. Economics	Bachelors Degree with at least 50% marks* having Economics/ Mathematics /Statistics as one of the subjects. OR Bachelors Degree in Agriculture with at least 50% marks*.
M.A./M.Sc Mathematics	Bachelors Degree with at least 50% marks* with Mathematics/ Applied Mathematics as one of the subjects.
M.A. in Convergent Journalism	Bachelors Degree in any Discipline with at least 50% marks*.
Integrated B.A. LLB	10+2 with at least 50% marks* from a recognized Board.

General Conditions:-

1. Admission to the above programmes would be made on the basis of Central Universities Common Entrance Test (**CUCET**) to be conducted jointly by Central Universities of Bihar, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kashmir, Kerala, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu on June 18-19, 2010.
2. Online forms for Common Entrance Test are available on www.cucet.ac.in . The Offline forms along with the prospectus can be obtained from the Transit Campus of the University against cash payment of Rs. 150/= (100 for Sc/ ST) from 12th of May, 2011. Through this Common Application form, eligible students can apply for any of the programmes offered by the above Universities.
3. **The last date for receipt of online and offline application is 4th June 2011.** The offline application forms (**without any certificates or enclosures**) along with the requisite fee, in the form of a D.D drawn in favour of Co-ordinator "CUCET – 2011", payable at Thiruvapur, should be either sent to, "**Blueshift Information Systems Private Limited** " 6th Floor, East Wing, Sreyas Towers, 23 & 24, Chamiers Road, Chennai – 600 018 OR can be submitted by hand at the Central University of Kashmir .
4. The test shall be conducted at Ajmer, Allahabad, Bangalore, Belgaum, Bhagalpur, Bhubaneswar, Bikaner, Chennai, Kovai (Coimbatore), Darbhanga, Dhanbad, Dharwad, Gulbarga, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Jammu, Jamshedpur, Jodhpur, Kasargod, Kochi, Kolkata, Kozhikode, Kota, Madurai, Mumbai, Mysore, New Delhi, Patna, Ranchi, Silchar, Srinagar, Thiruvananthapuram, Thiruvapur and Udaipur . If the number of candidates opting for a particular centre is not viable, they will be allocated the nearest centre.
5. Applicants awaiting final results in the qualifying examination may also apply. However, their admission will be subject to their getting the eligibility marks in the qualifying examination, the proof of which shall be submitted before the last date fixed for the completion of the admission formalities by the Universities concerned
